CRB1. Charter Amendments

Chancery Note: These listings are based on the Membership Summary as of the date of publication.

- A. Consider reducing the following Chapters in status due to insufficient numbers:
 - 1. Duchy of Lancaster (*Requires majority to reduce*)
 Current membership: 18
- B. Crown decision regarding Shires with fewer than 5 members:
 - 1. Shire of Sherwood Current membership: 3
- C. Request for change in chartered territory

(Requires majority to approve.)

1. The Archduchy of Alhambra would like to incorporate the mundane areas of Walla Walla, Franklin, and Benton Counties of Washington State.

Author's Commentary: With HIM permission we have been using the area for the canton of Stonehaven, and we are looking to increase the numbers there. There is not much in the area around the canton but it becomes a far more convenient location than driving 3 miles to the main body of Alhambra. In addition is is also a good striking distance to Oregon, in our hopes to support Gloucester and not see it fail.

The Estates of Alhambra have voted to accept the proposed change in territory with a supermajority. Presently, the territory in question is Imperial land.

CRB2. Updated Steward's Manual (Formerly IEW-3; presently ICW)

(Requires majority to adopt as IEW; requires majority to reject as ICW. Will remain ICW with no action from Estates.)

Updated manual **DRAFT** published separately on the July Agenda/Minutes page; old version posted separately on the July Agenda/Minutes page for comparison. At the July meeting, the Crowns and Stewards from each chapter were tasked with reading the draft manual and submitting at least 3 questions or comments on it for consideration in revisions. No revised manual has been submitted to date.

VII. CHANCERY BUSINESS

CHB1. Court Reports

A. Judicial Courts

No notices or judgments received.

B. Civil Courts

(Requires majority to ratify.)

On July 27, 2019, a Civil Court was convened in response to Sir Fyodor of Terre Neuve's request to evaluate his eligibility for the accolade of Knight Champion. Justices HIM Babette Bryn Corey, HRM Fafnir Halgrim, and Edelinne d'Orsay presided. The Petitioner alleged that he had earned sufficient combat points to qualify for the accolade of Knight Champion, but due to record-keeping failures of the Organization, documentation of the points earned as a member of Annelynnrose were lost. Upon review of evidence including Adria newsletters citing the activities of Annelynnrose, written and oral statements from witnesses, and partial STKs showing points recovered by Imperial Minister of Rolls and Lists, as well as questioning of Sir Fyodor, it was ruled that Sir Fyodor is eligible to receive the accolade of Knight Champion as of the date of the ruling. Missing points and events shall not be fabricated to fill gaps in the STK; should further documentation become available, these points may be entered accordingly.

CHB2. Clarification of the Will of the Estates re: Arts Manual Edit

(Requires majority to approve.)

A portion of the verbiage of Article V.D.11 was inadvertently changed by the author in the proposed manual clarifications, and the proposal was then accepted by the Estates. The affected text pertained to the five-point spread. The inadvertent change was as follows:

The MA&S shall discuss with the judge any score that differs by more than five from the average score. The judge shall have the opportunity to adjust the score to be more in line the other scores.

The existing manual verbiage is as follows:

The MA&S shall discuss any score that differs by more than five from the other score used with the judge, who shall have the opportunity to adjust the score to be more in line the other scores or that judge will be replaced by two new judges and the same criteria shall be applied.

Option 1: Reaffirm the 10-point spread rule adopted in July.

The MA&S shall discuss with the judge any score that differs by more than five from the average score. The judge shall have the opportunity to adjust the score to be more in line the other scores.

Option 2: Adjust the newly-adopted verbiage to maintain the current 5-point spread rule.

The MA&S shall discuss with the judge any score that differs by more than five from the other scores used. The judge shall have the opportunity to adjust the score to be more in line the other scores.

IX. NEW BUSINESS

NB1. Revision of the Imperial Calendar

(Discussion automatic. Requires 2/3 to consider and 2/3 to approve.)

This item was tabled again in July for further discussion. Several alternatives to the current Imperial Calendar have been proposed, and are illustrated in Appendix B. Please refer to past minutes for discussion notes.

Option 1:

- In-Person Imperial Estates Meetings in January and July
- Imperial Wars on Memorial Day and Labor Day weekends

Option 2:

- In-Person Imperial Estates Meetings in April and November
- GoToMeeting Imperial Estates Meeting in August
- Imperial Wars on Memorial Day and Labor Day weekends

Option 3:

- In-Person Imperial Estates Meetings in March and November
- GoToMeeting Imperial Estates Meeting in July
- Imperial Wars on Memorial Day and Labor Day weekends

Option 4:

• Keep as normal except change March to GoToMeeting

Authors' commentary: A Facebook poll indicated that the majority of members prefer keeping the Imperial Wars on Memorial Day and Labor Day weekends. The Option 1 calendar keeps the July IEM, although the dates for this meeting can be fluid within the month to adjust for conflicts with large local demos. The Option 2 calendar moves the IEM out of March, which is traditionally a terrible traveling month for all areas weather-wise, and removes the summer IEM in favor of a GoToMeeting IEM. The Option 3 calendar is the current calendar but with the substitution of a GoToMeeting for the July IEM.

NB2. Amendment of Combat Manual re: Rapier Blades

Option 1:

Amend III.G.1. Rapier Blades as follows:

- 1. Rapier Blades
 - a. Nominal 1/2 to 1 inch width A 1 inch to 1/2 inch nominal width down the entire length of the blade.

i. The applicable definition of the word 'Nominal' being taken from the Merriam-Webster dictionary which states ~ ': of, being, or relating to a designated or theoretical size that may vary from the actual: APPROXIMATE.' For Adrian purposes, a standard of 1/16 inch be used for incremental measure.

Option 2:

Amend III.G.1. Rapier Blades as follows:

- 1. Rapier Blades
 - a. Nominal 1/2 to 1 inch width A minimum 1/2 inch nominal width down the entire length of the blade not to be smaller than 3/8th of an inch at the tip.

- i. The applicable definition of the word 'Nominal' being taken from the Merriam-Webster dictionary which states ~ ': of, being, or relating to a designated or theoretical size that may vary from the actual: APPROXIMATE.' For Adrian purposes, a standard of 1/16 inch be used for incremental measure.
- ii. <u>Epées, foils, and triangular-profile blades are not allowed due to</u> the risk of breaking into sharp, irregular ends, that if puncture will cause serious injury.

Due to its length, author's commentary will be made available upon request rather than reproduced here. Synopsis: clarify language to prevent combatants from bringing foils and epees onto the field due to safety concerns; define 'nominal' "to help increase understanding of the text and expand the vocabulary of the marshalate and populace at large."


