*Argent, a cross potent Vert surmounted by a crown enfiled of a chalice of the First between four fleur-de-lys crosswise Or.*

*Gules, a wolf's head erased Argent.*

*Purpure, a chevron dancetty counter-dancetty between in base a hand apaume argent and in chief 2 lions combatant guardant Or.*

*[Fieldless] A lily Argent.*

*\*NOTE: An 'Argent Fleur-de-lis' is for use to Sees of the Church of Adria and by those specifically designated to do so by augmentation. The use of an 'Argent Lily,' (the true form of a fleur-de-lis), may be used by all who wish to represent themselves as a member of the Church of Adria. This charge is able to be registered without the need of being an augmentation.*

*Per bend Gules and Or, 2 dragons embowed biting their own tails Counterchanged, overall a bend wavy Pean.*

#### **COMMENTS:**

*This device was presented as being matriculated in the SCA, hence should be registered in Adria.*

*After much research and in consultation with the Imperial Sovereign of Arms, I have concluded:*

*(1) the charge of a 'serpent (or snake) biting it's own tail' (actually blazoned as 'serpent involved') is able to be documented;*

*(2) even though this device was registered in the SCA as 'dragon embowed biting their own tails,' (actually blazoned as 'dragon dormant in annulo'), a beast (other than a serpent or snake) in this position, is an heraldic invention of the SCA;*

*(3) the SCA differentiates serpents from dragons.*

*Sir Nigel, when he was the Imperial Sovereign of Arms, commented on the topic of "If it is registered in the SCA, it is registerable in Adria":*

*"SCA: 1. Registration in the SCA means that there's a good chance that registration in Adria will follow, this is not always the case. To tighten this rule-of-thumb: Registration by the SCA within the past two years means that there is a good chance that, barring conflict, it will be registerable in Adria. Our rules are different from the SCA's rules, even if some of our rules are based on the SCA's. We are gradually moving away from the SCA's style and working towards building our own. As we get further and further away from SCA-style heraldry, the less likely it is that a given piece of SCA-registered armory will be acceptable in Adria."*

#### **RULING (1):**

***A dragon (or other beasts), (other than a serpent or snake or the like) in the position 'in annulo' cannot be registered in Adria.***

#### **RULING (2):**

***Armory matriculated in the SCA, ECS, or any other organization recognized by the Adrian Empire, are not guaranteed that they will be passed by Adria's Imperial College of Arms.***

# Order of Protection

## *~ Devices of Historic Chartered Subdivisions ~*

\*NOTE: The following devices of now defunct **Chartered Subdivisions** of the Empire of Adria. These Arms are protected as **Historic** and can never be released. Any Chartered Subdivision that the Imperial Estates deem as closed, shall have their Arms added to these rolls and will be protected.

\*\*NOTE: As of this date, any device, badge or flag of any person, estate or other than a person or estate cannot conflict with these protected devices. Any device, badge or flag currently **Imperially registered** are considered Grandfathered and cannot be released due to the fact that they are in conflict with these newly protected Arms.

*Gules, in pale a crown and a sun in splendor Or.*

**Avernus, Shire of** (Historical Chartered Subdivision)  
*Argent, a bend sinister Sable.*

**Bedegraine, Shire of** (Historical Chartered Subdivision)  
*Per chevron Or and Sable, 2 laurel wreaths and a tower Counterchanged.*

**Brittany, Duchy of** (Historical Chartered Subdivision)  
*Sable, a Mullet Or.*

**Crescent Moon, Shire of** (Historical Chartered Subdivision)  
*Azure chapé ploye Or, in chief 2 fleur-de-lys Or, in base a conifer tree Proper.*

*Gules, an oak tree Sable.*
- Dragons Mist, Duchy of** (Historical Chartered Subdivision)  
*Vert, a dragon Or.*
- DunAfton, Shire of** (Historical Chartered Subdivision)  
*Azure, on a mound with 3 peaks beneath 7 mullets of eight, in chevron a sword inverted Azure.*
- Dunvegan, Duchy of** (Historical Chartered Subdivision)  
*Per pale Vert and Azure, a pale wavy Or, overall a castle Argent.*
- Galanache Dragun, Shire of** (Historical Chartered Subdivision)  
*Azure, a serpent in gurgles Or.*
- Glaston, Viceroyalty of** (Historical Chartered Subdivision)  
*Azure, on a bend Gules fimbriated, 3 fleur-de-lys palewise Argent.*
- Grenfell, Shire of** (Historical Chartered Subdivision)  
*Per fess Argent and Gules, 3 swords fesswise Counterchanged.*
- Hanover, Shire of** (Historical Chartered Subdivision)  
*Per bend Vert and Or, a sun in splendor Counterchanged.*
- Isenwold, Shire of** (Historical Chartered Subdivision)  
*Gules, a mountain issuant from base Or.*
- Lone Star, Shire of** (Historical Chartered Subdivision)  
*Per pale Azure and Argent, a mullet Counterchanged.*
- Lyon, Shire of** (Historical Chartered Subdivision)  
*Vert, a lion in splendor Or.*
- Navarre, Duchy of** (Historical Chartered Subdivision)  
*Quarterly 1 and 4: Or, a portcullis gules; 2: Or, a fleur-de-lis Gules;  
3: Argent, a fleur-de-lis Or.*
- Neu Eisenwold, Duchy of** (Historical Chartered Subdivision)  
*Sable, on a bend sinister Gules between 2 estoiles 3 water-bougets Or*
- Pembroke, Kingdom of** (Historical Chartered Subdivision)  
*Sable, a cross fleury Or.*

**Rathlin Isle, Duchy of** (Historical Chartered Subdivison)  
*Azure, on a bend Gules, between 2 fleur-de-lys palewise Or, a rose Argent.*

**Silvowitz, Shire of** (Historical Chartered Subdivison)  
*Argent, on a bend sinister Vert 3 cups palewise Or.*

**Snowden, Duchy of** (Historical Chartered Subdivison)  
*Argent, three crabs Gules.*

**Thatuna, Shire of** (Historical Chartered Subdivison)  
*Per chevron Azure and Vert, 2 axes Argent and a garb Or.*

**Tierra Del Fuego, Archduchy of** (Historical Chartered Subdivison)  
*Argent, on a chevron Gules, 3 martlets Argent.*
