Cases from the previous Administration:

1. Sir Dorn vs Sir Prize: Found without Merit
2. Dame Antonia vs Sir Prize: Found without Merit (processed by Dame Arianna in the previous administration, confirmed by this administration)
3. Prince Wright vs Count Hawthorne: In mediation

Cases for this reign:

1. Dame Freydis, and The Chivalry (represented by Sir Henry, Dame Isobel and Sir Bjorn) vs Sir Cagar: Merit was found for Conduct Unbecoming a Knight. Status: Crown Justice has been requested
2. Countess Cocah vs Duke Prize: Found without Merit
3. Princess Shahara vs Duke Prize: Found without Merit
4. Count Liam, and the Chivalry (represented by Princess Shahara, Count Liam and Countess Cocah) vs Duke Prize: Merit was found for the charge of Conduct Unbecoming a Knight. Status: A Royal Court was requested for the March IEM.

Civil Courts:

A Civil Court was requested related to borders and Charters.

Plans:

Barring no flurry of new complaints, the team plans to prepare and clarify procedures for trials and merit based on previous rulings of Law and any agenda items that are approved at this IEM and prepare it for a future IEM proposal.
