

Report – Rolls Minister

Rolls review is moving along. Sometimes mundania interferes for all of us, but this time around I see a great deal of effort has been made by the chapters to keep things rolling smoothly. Some chapters need an occasional prompt, and we are still often receiving several months of submissions at one time. A reminder, please. Events are due within 30 days of the event (or sooner). This will allow prompt review and award of points to members.

Imperial Challenge is off to a great start. Tracking sheets for the challenge should be submitted to the Imperial Rolls office no later than 2 days after the end of that month. This will allow for proper recognition of participants. Tracking sheets are to be used. Rolls Ministers and Crowns should have a copy. If not, I will be happy to provide one on request.

A revised Event sign in sheet was recently placed on the website. This sheet made allowance for crossbows. Also, the terminology for Rawlings was corrected to waster. My apologies for any who, like myself, print a stack of forms ahead of time. This was an oversight and should not happen often. We are also working to revise the Archery STK and archery sign in sheet to show cross bow activity. When those are completed, a copy will be placed in the library and notice will be sent to the Imperial Archery Minister, Chapter Crowns and Rolls Ministers.
