IX. OLD BUSINESS

X. NEW BUSINESS

NB1. Creation of the Imperial Order of the Knight Esteemed

(Discussion automatic. Requires 2/3 majority to consider. Requires majority to approve.)

. To become a member of the Imperial Order of the Knight Esteemed, one must have earned 1st, 2nd, and 3rd level knighthood in a discipline by qualifying using only the highest level of participation in that discipline. This requires a total of 89 Knight's List Tournament Wins (or Masterworks) for Archery, Combat or Arts plus 7 Masterworks for Arts, and 116 DIs for ministry; 25 discipline related DIs for Ministry, and 16 Participations as a Range Master, Minister of Arts & Science, Minister of War & Joust or Crown Marshal, or Autocrat, or their assistant (e.g. marshal, judge, ...), as appropriate for the discipline, at wars.

An individual can become a Knight Esteemed each of the 4 disciplines.

This order bestows precedence equal to an Imperial Baron or Baroness.

Members of this order may augment their arms or wear the badge of the order* for the discipline(s) for which they are a member:

Combat: A fleur-de-lis enfiled of a sword Or**

Arts: A fleur-de-lis enfiled of a paint brush bendwise Or

Ministry: A fleur-de-lis enfiled of a quill bendwise sinister Or

Archery: A fleur-de-lis enfiled of an arrows fesswise Or

Author Commentary: It has been said that there is no "goal" for a knight once they have reached 3rd level. This order would give knights that goal and recognize those few who have "gone the extra mile" to "prove their worth".

When I first proposed this in a discussion, complaints were made that the version of the war point requirement did not show proper prowess or was "too political" as being the Range Master, MoWJ, Arts Minister, or Autocrat for a war was a "political" appointment. I suggest that, by not requiring them to be the "politically appointed" person-in-charge, there should be more than adequate opportunity for 3rd level knights to serve in these positions regardless of who is Crown. Or, if this body feels that being the "assistant" is not adequate and that the Crowns will be, as they should, fair enough to give any qualified knight the opportunity to serve in these positions, at "fun" wars especially, and given that each chapter is authorized to hold up to 4 wars/year and service can be rendered in other chapters and the Empire.

The only problem I see at this point is the need to verify that the (demo replacing) DIs and War Points were "discipline related". This requirement was put in to show that the knight has been "teaching what they know", not just learning to improve their prowess. Again, I am open to (read that as "I am requesting") suggestions to "make this work".

NB2. Creation of a standard for Rangemaster qualification.

(Discussion automatic. Requires 2/3 majority to consider. Requires majority to approve.)

As no current law exists regarding qualification for Rangemasters, it is proposed that the following be added to IEW 52 in Section I.D between items 1 and 2.

Rangemasters at Adrian events must have completed a Rangemaster qualification course with the following requirements.

1. Pass the archery written test with a minimum score of 90%
2. Pass the Rangemaster test with a minimum score of 90%
3. Assist a qualified Rangemaster with range safety at a minimum of 3 events.
4. Take a Rangemaster class..

Seated Crowns are exempt from the qualification requirements. To maintain Rangemaster qualifications, a member must attend a Rangemaster class and participate in a Rangemaster capacity at least once every two years. If a member allows their qualification to lapse, they will be required to repeat the qualification glass and range master written test before they can be reinstated.

Rangemaster cards must be signed by a local Crown, Archery Minister, or qualified Rangemaster.

Author Commentary: If passed, the Imperial Archery Minister, with the input and assistance of the Estates and Ministers will create a range master test and qualification card to submit for Estates approval no later than the next IEM. It is requested by the author that this law, if passed, go into effect at the time of the IEM following approval of the test and qualification card.

Possible examples of the qualification card can be found as Appendix C. An example of a possible test will be uploaded separately.

NB3. Set a timeframe for location of War sites for Imperial Banner War and Imperial Crown War weekends.

(Discussion automatic. Requires 2/3 majority to consider. Requires majority to approve.)

The Imperial Crowns shall ensure that war sites for Imperial Banner War (Memorial Day weekend) and Imperial Crown War (Labor Day Weekend) shall be secured no less than 9 months prior to the events in the following five regions: Canada, Northwest, Southwest, Northeast, Southeast, as well as any additional sites that are desired. While it is expected that support will be provided by the local regions in submitting bids for these sites, it is ultimately the responsibility of the Imperial Crowns to have sites scheduled and reserved.

Author Commentary: We know that these wars are going to happen every year. We should be planning better than waiting until a few months beforehand to get something found and scheduled. Most sites book a year in advance and we should be striving for that.

NB4. Update Lex Adria Imperium to follow a uniform timeline regarding Imperial Coronation and November IEM.

(Discussion automatic. Requires 2/3 majority to consider. Requires 2/3 majority to approve.)

Under Article VI.E.3, Meeting Date, November, it is listed that the Imperial Estates shall meet on the second Saturday of November, and the following day if needed.

Under Article XIV, Terms of Office, Section A, it states that the Emperor/Empress shall rule from Coronation (The first weekend of November of the year of ascent to the Throne) until the Coronation of the Imperial Heirs Apparent (the first weekend of November in the following year.)

Under Article XIV Term of Office, Section F.4 it states With regard to Imperial Heirs Apparent determined at regular Imperial War on Labor Day Weekend, coronation shall occur on the first weekend in November.

The following options are presented as means to provide a uniform timeline for the November IEM and Coronation.

Option 1: Coronation and Imperial Estates meeting shall happen on the first weekend of November.

Option 2: Coronation and Imperial Estates meeting shall happen on the second weekend of November.

Option 3: Coronation shall happen on the first weekend of November, and the November Imperial Estates Meeting will happen on the second Saturday of November as a virtual meeting.

Author Commentary: *We have a conflict of dates that needs to be updated to reflect the timeline we as an organization desire. If option 3 is desired it would allow for more effort to be put forth for a large coronation event to include tournaments and collegia instead of a business meeting. Either way, the time lines need to correlate to what we as an Empire want.*

Chancellor Note: *The Imperial Estates voted to move the November IEM to the second weekend in November to avoid potential conflicts with Halloween. Coronation was not specifically voted on, but it was a part of the same discussion.*

APPENDIX D.

Statement of Work/Request for Proposal for Member Information Database

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Introduction:

The Adrian Empire is a 501c3 not-for-profit educational organization specializing in medieval recreation. We are an international organization with approximately 1000 members in local chapters in regions throughout the United States of America and Canada.

The Adrian Empire was founded in 1987 by medievalists interested in practicing live steel combat.

Purpose:

The Adrian Empire is a merit-based organization, meaning that certain progression is achieved by participating in events or gatherings in multiple ways, which is tracked and counted (“points”) towards a specific goal. A database is required to accurately keep track of and show that participation.

Scope of Work:

The vendor shall create and/or set up and maintain a secure database containing member information including legal information and pertaining to their activities within the Adrian Empire.

The database must be compatible with information in the current database so as not to lose any information currently on record and to mitigate, as much as possible, any challenges in training current users on the new database. Current table examples that do not contain protected information will be provided upon request. Any table or tables containing protected/proprietary information shall not be released until successful signing of a contract.

The database tables will be compatible with the same technology as the organization’s website to allow members to view their personal information as well as expectancies as outlines further in this document (under the section titled “Website Connectivity, in particular). The vendor shall create a front-end connection to the organization’s website to allow authorized users to update the database.

The vendor will provide reasonable technical support options for issues that may arise in the normal operation of the database. The vendor will provide the ability to access and append the database to select members of the Adrian Empire with varying access requirements that will be outlined within this document.

The work shall include but is not limited to the following and may require linking to other database sources.

Website Connectivity

The database entries need to connect to each member’s persona page in a manner that summarizes their participation by each discipline with the ability to expand each discipline section to view the complete event and participation list for that event.

Adrian Empire Laws indicate that except in certain circumstances, only one event or war point may be achieved per month in any of the disciplines. The webpage interface from the database must reflect and accurately show those rules. See Appendix

The page should be able to calculate when a step on the member’s StK has been achieved, ensuring that the member is automatically made aware of the achievement.

The knighthoods and awards recorded in the database should be visible on the same page.

The member should be able to export the information under each discipline into an excel file.

Emailing

Once an event has been created or its status has been changed to “Local Review”, “Imperial Review”, or “Imperial Acceptance” an email should be automatically generated to the email addresses associated with that event or the option to send an email indicating the change has been made.

An email dropdown can be added to each event creation/management page to designate who gets the email pertaining to that event.

Appendix A: Security

All members will need to log in to the site to have access to view anything. Guests or members who do not log in will not be able to see anyone’s legal name or personal details and will be limited to seeing only persona names and unsecured pages.

Access to the database is secured through password protection. The login to the database is through the following page [Can be changed depending on whether any new website uses a different address]
<https://www.adrianempire.org/ministers/minRolls.php>.

Upon initial access granting, an email with a new username and password will be automatically sent to the member email address listed in the database. Usernames can be changed by persons authorized by their access authority, but they should not be able to view individual member passwords.

Upon initial login after granting access, the user should be prompted to change their password from a default password created by the system.

A multi-factor authentication protocol will be required for password retrieval with a random password auto generated by the system.

XIV. Access Level Definitions and access allowed.

The access levels are listed in ascending order with “Guest” being the lowest level.

- Guest
 - No password required.
 - Not a member.
 - Able to access and view public pages and sections.
 - Default views, such as in a chapter member list will not show member legal (mundane) names but will show game names.
 - Cannot see members’ legal names or any private information.

- **Member**
 - Basic Member level.
 - Password required.
 - Able to access and view public pages.
 - Able to access and view member pages.
 - Can see legal names and some private information.
 - Can request audit of their StK from their member page.
 - Can export data from a member page for StK review.
 - Can search for other members.
- **Local Rolls Deputy**
 - Same access as “Member” level. Must be a registered member with password to be eligible for this access level.
 - Ability to access rolls database.
 - Can create an event for any chapter(s) to which they are assigned.
 - Can change event status from “Entry” to “Local Review” or vice versa.
 - Can view events of any status for the chapter(s) to which they are assigned.
 - Can add awards to a member from the chapter(s) to which they are assigned.
 - Can add knighthoods to a member from the chapter(s) to which they are assigned.
- **Local Rolls Minister**
 - Same access as any lower level.
 - Can add a local deputy to any chapter(s) to which they are assigned.
 - Can export event reports for the chapter(s) to which they are assigned.
 - Can create, edit, and delete local awards.
- **Local Crown**
 - Same access as any lower level.
 - Exception – cannot create new events, can only review.
 - Can change event status to any status, up to “Imperial Review”.
- **Imperial Rolls Deputy**
 - Same access as any lower level.
 - Can view/edit/create events in any chapter.
 - Can mark the “Imperial Exception” box (see C2. Under Database Setup)
 - Can change event to and from any event status.
 - Can add Imperial (Chapter: Adria) to any member.
- **Imperial Rolls Minister**
 - Same access as any lower level.
 - Can export event list containing all chapters.
 - Can create/edit Imperial awards.
 - Can edit or remove awards on any member.
 - Can assign roles to any member (Access Levels), creating, editing, or removing access to rolls database.
 - Can export current member list for all chapters.

- Imperial Crown
 - Administrator – level access equal to all lower level.
 - Exception – Cannot enter events, can only review.

Appendix B: Checks and Balances

XV. Error Trapping

This section applies to event creation and maintenance as well as the member and persona management sections to give the user a way to double-check their work and confirm its accuracy before the record is saved to the database.

During the above processes there is currently a button, “Confirm” that is clicked, which brings the user to another screen with the information in a reviewable format with another “Confirm” button to click to save the information.

The first “Confirm” button should be “Review” which will bring the user to a review screen with text or a pop-up stressing the importance of making sure the information is correct before proceeding.

XVI. Change Logs

Any time a change is made to a database item a log needs to be made recording what change was made, which user made that change, and when it was made.

A report needs to be able to be pulled of these logs, dependent on the access level of the user. (Example, local rolls minister or crown can see their own events and members and imperial ministers or crowns should be able to pull the change logs of everything)..

XVII. Database points to webpage

The following is taken from our rolls manual to describe the one point per month limitation. It is for reference to help explain how points show up on the website (see Appendix D: Sample Member/Persona Page for examples)

Per the Adrian Empire Lex Adria Article V.F. only one participation point (Event Participation (EP) or War Participation (WP)) and Tournament Win (TW) counts towards advancement to knighthood in each discipline (Archery, Arts, Combat, and Ministry). Demo Participations (DP’s), Demo Initiations (DI’s), and

Arts Masterworks (MW's) are not subject to this limitation. The exceptions to this are Imperial Tournaments (EPs and TW's), Imperial Wars (WP's), and Imperial Estates Meetings (Ministry EPs) which may be counted in addition to a local participation or win in the same month.

Rolls ministers should always record the facts as they occur. The check for multiple points in to be verified and prevents possible point losses due to certain corrections that may occur. Furthermore, this method easily allows situations such as a Combat EP at one event and an Archery EP at a different event within the same month to both be counted. The same category should be done as part of an audit. The Imperial Database report automatically marks these points. Following this procedure allows things such as minimum tournament participants.

Only the Imperial Rolls office may enter Imperial Events into the Imperial Database. When entering an event that qualifies as an exception to the one-point-per-month rules, it shall be marked accordingly (Imperial Exception indicator). This will automatically allow the additional points to show up on each member's rolls report web page.

Appendix C: Glossary

Bowman's List: This is an archery list for beginner or less experienced archers.

Chapter: Chapter is used to designate a specific group within the Adrian Empire that meet in one area and

Discipline: The Adrian Empire has four divisions which are labeled "disciplines". They are Archery, Combat, Robe (Arts & Sciences), and Ministry. Each discipline has its own methods for earning points.

Entry: This is the default event status upon creation of the event and denotes that a rolls minister is currently in the process of entering the event information.

EP: Event Point. This is a point for attending the event and participating in that discipline.

Event Status: The status of an event (Entry, Local Review, Imperial Review, Imperial Acceptance). See individual entries for explanation of each status.

Huntsman's List: This is an archery list for more experienced archers who have progressed through participation, normally with at least one or two tournament wins achieved.

Imperial Acceptance: This is an event status that indicates that the event has passed final imperial review, and the information can be displayed on the member pages.

Imperial Exception: This is a check box in an event to allow the event to bypass the one event per month rule.

Imperial Review: This is an event status that indicates that the local crowns have reviewed the event for accuracy and that it is ready for the Imperial Rolls Minister (or deputy) and/or Imperial Crowns to conduct a final review of the event, before closing it.

Knight's List: This is a combat list for fighters who are more experienced who have progressed through the sergeant's list and typically have a tournament win or two. It is the only list that steel combat can be competed on.

Local Review: This is an event status that indicates that a rolls minister has finished entering the event information and it is ready for the local crowns to review the event for accuracy.

Rolls: Like roll call, a list of attendees for an event and any specific discipline within an event.

Sergeant's List: This is a combat list for younger or less experienced fighters. It is the only list in which shinai can be competed on.

StK: This stands for "Steps to Knighthood". It is how the Adrian Empire compiles the participation and achievements of its members. Each discipline has a requirement to reach one of three levels of knighthood. The database helps us to track those accomplishments to properly celebrate a member's achievements.

WP: War point. This is a type of point awarded participating in a particular discipline at a war event.
