The foundation of Adria is based upon certain principles of authority and law. When one finds themselves in conflict with these principals, it is not within their right to work outside of these principles. Yet to respect that this structure is essentially designed to protect the authority of the Imperial Crown and the rights of the membership. That being acknowledged: It is obvious that the transition of current and archive files for the Imperial Steward / Secretary / Treasurer office caused unwarranted duress for all concerned. I hope that you know my every intention has been the good of the Empire, even though the execution of the transfer was less than what I wished or what it ought to have been. I acknowledge the e-mail to cease and desist received on November 5, 2008. My action on November 11, 2008 in sending an e-mail to the CPA's office to address a transaction I thought had been resolved was done in haste and did not even follow my own guidelines of copying people involved and following the law. I spend 3 years telling people to read the By-Laws and established practices and then turned around and ignored my own advice. I sincerely apologize to TIM and the Empire for any inconsistencies, misconceptions, unwarranted duress and inconvenience that my actions may have caused during this transition.
