NEW HERALDRY MANUAL: RULES FOR REGISTRATON, ADMINISTRATION AND DESIGN

After many years of contemplation I wish to present a new Manual of Heraldry. In essence this manual is a compilation of all heraldic rules and education strewn out over years. Replacing the Heraldry Manual: Rules for Registration and Administration, the Policies and Precedents Guide, How to Blazon Guide and all other rules and policies found through out our great history. New, are samples which may help guide presenters and Heralds through out the Empire. It is also restructured so as to allow greater reference to specific topics. The Rules are essentially the same yet have been modified to reflect current practices especially in the area of registration. It is my hope that there is better clarification over important aspects of design that I have noticed confusion with in the past years. This took a while to accomplish and of course is not perfect. So I make a charge to all heralds current and future to expand on what is started here. Being Foremost the educational aspect, we have plenty of rules so it is time to start educating. I have found that for most "Adrian Heraldry" is better absorbed by examples, than by the written word alone.

Also, this Manual has nothing to do with Sumptuary or Armigerious rights. I caution the future members of the College to focus on what we were created for: Education of Heraldic Design and Registration of the Arms of the Empire. Stay the course!

Lastly, I announce now that no matter the outcome of the coming war, I shall step down as the Imperial Sovereign of Arms in November. I shall give and take recommendations of a suitable replacement. To all the deputies who have served under me, I thank you, there have only been a handful of Heralds in the Empire who have "walked the talk" so to speak. I have had the fortune to work with the best. To the future Heralds of the Empire, this job is work! There is little glory in being Fleur de Lys King of Arms. For myself at the end of this service all I truly know is that "I tried my best to serve and help." History will decide if it was enough.
