Gules, three feathers Or.

Sable, three cross's patees in pale argent.

Fieldless, a cross crosslet fitchy Or surmounted by a pellet.

Per pale vert and sable, a skull enfiled of two arrows inverted in saltire Or.

- **Conflict:** Sable, a cat passant argent. [E-House of Wessex, YORK] No Cd given between Types of the Cat family, only one CD for posture.

Azure, a sealion guardant Or and on a chief wavy sable three estoiles argent.

- **Violation of HMRRA.I.A.** Though recent changes allow for a sable chief on an azure field, lines such as “Wavy” are considered complex and are not allowed under this provision.

Gules, crusily fitchy Or

- **Conflict:** Mundane: Lord of Warwick: Gules, crusily Or

Fieldless, a cross crosslet fitchy Or.

- **Conflict:** Argent, a cross Or. [F-Empire of Adria, IMP]
 - one CD for Fieldless no CD for type of Cross. Also HMRRA XI.D.1

Argent, a shamrock vert surmounted by a harp Or

- **Conflict:** Ireland Badge: Argent, a Shamrock vert
 - Only one CD for addition of Harp.

Etienne la Guerre**Badge**

Or, semy-de-lis sable 3 bendlets azure.

- **Precedent:** Previous Adrian precedent has stated that bendlets must be used in even numbers (two bendlets, four bendlets etc..) this is to differentiate between fields which are “Bendy”. Bendy requires the field to be divided into even partitions, 3 Or partitions, 3 azure partitions. The difference created by using bendlets is a uneven look of partitions on a field which make it distinguishable as bendlets.

Gyronny arrondee gules and or.

Policy: Offensive political theme.

HMRRA IX. A.3. STEREOTYPES

- Armory suggesting derogatory ethnic, racial, or sexual stereotypes will not be permitted, even if adequately documented. This applies whether the stereotype is explicit or implied.

HMRRA IX. A.4. OFFENSIVE POLITICAL THEMES

- The Swastika may not be registered due to mundane association with the Nazi party.

Ruling:

As mentioned in the documentation provided by the submitter, the proposed device is a variation of the swastika. Further, the emblazon resulting from the above blazon **visually appears** to be a variation on the Flurflot or “Twisted cross”.

Although the Flurflot itself may easily be documented as a period heraldic charge, it has come to be known universally in modern society as an “Offensive symbol”.

The Flurflot, it’s variations and/or by any other name (swastika) is on the list of patently offensive heraldic items and as such will not be registered in The Adrian Empire.
