From the Imperial Throne

We bring you greetings and thanks from your Imperial Crowns. We have much to say, so we will get right to it.

First, we did pass the following Writ in order to clear up some misunderstandings regarding tournament wins.

Here it is:

Unto the Estates of the Adrian Empire and it's populace:

Here now Our voice as we Speak for it is Imperial:

Be it known throughout the lands of Adria that on this day the fourteenth of November in the Year nineteen hundred and ninety eight We do issued this most Lawful and Just Writ.

That no member of the Adrian Empire may gain more then one tourney win per month in the same list (ie. Knight's list combat) for the purpose of gaining rank in the knightly orders. The only exception to this rule shall be in the case of attending an Imperial Tournament in the same month as a Crown Tournament.

What this means is that no member can gain more then one tourney win per knightly order per month. That means you can get one combat win and one arts win, but that's it. The Only exception will be if you attend an Imperial Tournament in that month.

Speaking of Imperial Tournaments, We will be hosting an Imperial Tournament in February. It will coincide with the Kingdom of Terre Nueve's feast of St Bella. It will be the Imperial Hearts and Honor Tournament and the Mistress if Ceremonies shall be Her Imperial Majesty Katayana Imperatrix, Tsarovna

of all the Adrias.

As you now, there was an Estates meeting in November. The Chancellor's Office should be finished with the minutes by the end of the month. Part of what was passed was an increase in dues. The basic membership will be increasing to \$30.00 a year. Additional Family memberships will be increasing to \$10.00 each, with a cap at \$70 per family. Six month memberships will increase to \$20.00 and \$7.50 respectively. As the Estates have given the right to the Imperial Crown to set the Price of Associate memberships on a case by case basis, We do hereby increase the Rates of all Associate memberships to \$10.00 each for a year. We expect all these increases to be in effect by January 1, 1999.

We will be sending out packets to all the Crown Heads containing all the updated manuals. This will include a new Heraldry manual, that We will put into place as a Crown Writ.

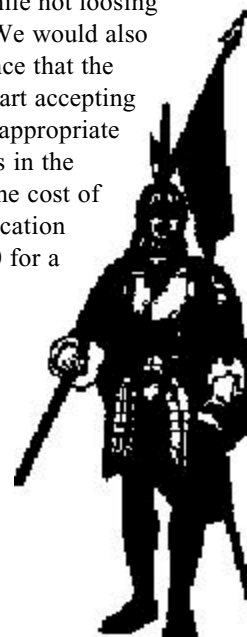

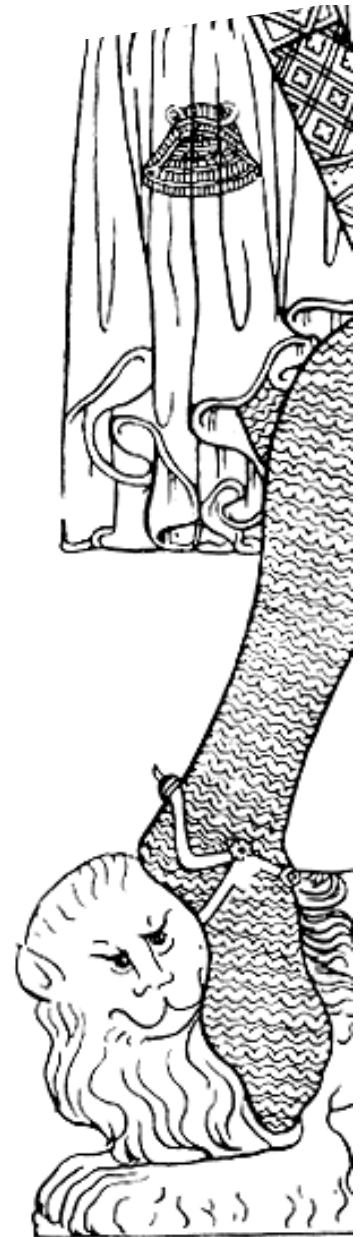
January Event: January 2 at Summer

Umbria

Greetings to the Populace of Adria in General and the Populace of Umbria in Particular.

We attended the Imperial Coronation Feast and want to express Our warmest gratitude to Her Imperial Majesty Katyana and His Imperial Majesty Stefan for their hospitality, the extraordinary victuals and the impeccable service.

We would like to thank Princess Isabeau, Princess Dorothea, and Lord Nigel for gracing Our Coronation Feast with their presence. I hope all of you enjoyed your visit to Umbria as much as We enjoyed having you here.

Special thanks to Lord Nigel for running the ceremony. All of Umbria is very grateful for your participation and prowess.

Saturday, December 19th will be the Kingdom Tourney at Cactus Park, 39th Ave and Cactus Rd, Phoenix. Opening Court will begin promptly at 10am. Please be aware that, as a matter of courtesy, events in Umbria start on time.

There will be a Collegium on Persona Development at the Tourney. We'll be working on names, personal histories and other ways of fleshing out your persona! Have more fun interacting with others!

The Kingdom of Umbria has monthly Estates meetings, which are at Noon each Crown Tourney. Expenses and other issues can be addressed at these brief, open gatherings.

Anyone interested in archery within Umbria should contact Sir Cameron Kilshannig, Waylon of Winchester, Drakona, or Toma. All of these fine folk are forming an Archer's Guild and want to encourage archery events, both at Tourneys and elsewhere.

The Kingdom has two new Guilds to help address and discuss issues within their area of expertise: The Warrior's Guild is chartered to deal with combat topics including armor standards, acknowledging blows, strength of blows, training, certification, new weapons and armor, etc. The Guild provides recommendations to the Minister of War & Joust, Crown Marshals, the Estates and the Crowns.

The Artisan's Guild is chartered to

discuss judging, documentation requirements and standards, tips and techniques, etc. The Guild provides recommendations to the Arts & Sciences Minister, the Estates and the Crowns. Membership in these Guilds is open to all interested Umbrians.

Knight's Councils: In Umbria, any Knight may call a Knight's Council to discuss an issue of concern. Knights are responsible for providing guidance to the populace and the Crowns. They are the guardians of tradition and custom within our Kingdom.

Resolving Disputes: As in any organization, disputes between persons can arise. The best way to handle them is privately, person-to-person. If that is not possible, use the following method: Ask a Knight to act as your Knight Advocate to address your grievance with the other person or that person's Knight Advocate. The two Knight Advocates should work together to help resolve the dispute. If no informal resolution can be agreed to by the two persons, the dispute should then be handled with a formal court appropriate to the nature of the charges and the persons involved. If the aggrieved person is not willing to call for a court, the matter is then considered closed and not discussed further. Let it be known that the Crowns of Umbria will view further discussion of a closed grievance as Disrupting the Harmony of the Game and possibly Conduct Unbecoming a Knight. Neither of these concepts have been heretofore defined. We are now providing the first definition of them in describing both a simple method of resolving disputes as well as consequences for not doing so. We hope that this helps improve dialog between all Umbrians and allows them to further enjoy each other's company and our Kingdom. We all have much to offer each other and to learn from each other.

Cantons: We encourage the expansion of Umbria by providing simple rules for the formation and continuing existence of Cantons. Anyone interested in establishing a Canton is welcome to do so, providing they understand the following: The first Canton event is 'free', meaning that there are no minimum requirements. All subsequent Canton events must have at least one combat tourney and one arts tourney (minimum 4 entries in each) to be

considered successful. An unsuccessful Canton tourney puts the Canton's existence in jeopardy. A second unsuccessful Canton tourney will result in the Canton's dissolution. Harsh? No, not really! Cantons are risky ventures, as were the historical Viceroyalties they represent. Also, Canton events need not be every month. They can be whenever the Viceroy wishes (with 30 days notice, of course). However, Ministry points for the Viceroy and Canton Ministers are only earned at Canton tourneys (successful or not). If you are interested in forming a Canton, contact the Crowns.

On December 4th, the four early music specialists of Musica Dolce will be joined by five wonderful vocalists of the Phoenix Chamber Singers at a concert of Medieval and Renaissance music at Kerr Cultural Center, 6110 N Scottsdale Rd. The concert is \$16 and starts at 8pm with a lecture/discussion at 7pm. All Umbrians are welcome to attend. Call 965-KERR for tickets. This is part of the Phoenix Early Music Society's Olde Musicke Series.
