Imperial Minister of Rolls Deputy: Dispensation of Points

Greetings one and all from His Lordship Sir Roy William MacCoda von Seiken Imperial Minister of Rolls deputy of the Adrian Empire

I am rapidly approaching my self-imposed deadline of iSomewhere in June or Julyi for publishing a iDoomsdayi book for the Empire.

I will have the software completed within the next couple of weeks. I will then forward said software to Brynna nan Tolman, the Imperial Minister of Rolls who will input what information she has regarding points, rank, titles and awards for the populace of the Adrian Empire. She will then press the button and generate the doomsday book for printing and distribution. It is up to each of us to provide her with accurate information regarding our points. If your house sire has not been sending in their Sireis reports, or your autocrat has not been turning in the event reports, it is up to

you to see that they do.

There has been some confusion regarding the dispensation of points.

This issue was brought to my attention at the Adria/ECS Friendship War.

I hope this clears things up for you.

The following excerpts are taken from the current By-laws of the Adrian Empire.

I copied the portions I wanted into a word document where the aggressive nature of the grammar and spell checkers went berserk. (The highlights and underlines are mine.

ARTICLE V: MEETINGS OF THE MEMBERSHIP

A. NOTICE

Official meetings of the Adrian Empire are jousts, tournaments, fairs, revels, or other events, the date, time and place of

which have been announced to the membership thirty (30) days prior to the event in the official newsletter or in a Crown's or Ruling Noble's court at an official event.



B. DEFINITION

An official event is any meeting of the membership, which is held in a medieval context, setting and style for the purpose of education, recreation and/or competition, as long as the event is sanctioned by the Crown. (Crown sanction may be revoked in writing for a just and stated cause.) Sponsored by a subdivision, announced thirty (30) days in advance to the membership through official channels, presided over by the Crown or a Ruling Noble, and attended by the ministry officials or their designated deputies responsible for the type of activity(ies) undertaken.

C. UNOFFICIAL EVENTS

Any event which does not conform to the specifications above, shall be considered

An unofficial event and any results of that event which require official status, shall not be recognized.

D. SPONSORSHIP REQUIREMENTS

All Ruling Nobles of the Estates Minor shall be required to sponsor one (1) Event per calendar year.

All Ruling Nobles of the Great Estates shall be required to sponsor two (2) events per calendar year.

All Ruling Royal Peers shall be required to sponsor one (1) Crown event per month, of which during the course of a year, two (2) must be war events.

The Ruling Imperial Peer shall be required to sponsor the Imperial Crown war and any war events which take place between two or more chartered subdivisions.

The Ruling Imperial Peer may not sponsor more than three (3) Imperial Crown events exclusive of the Imperial Crown War.

Not more than two (2) crown events may be war events, with the exception of a Crown or Civil war event.

A member shall not be allowed to participate in more than one (1) Crown event per month for purposes of meeting their requirements for advancement.

There are two exceptions to this:

Imperial Crown events
Crown/Civil Wars.

At all Crown events members shall be

afforded the opportunity to earn their requirements for advancement in their area of endeavor.†

The By-laws are clear in their meaning if not in the wording.

You may earn ONE (1) Crown tournament point per month.

You may earn ONE (1) Imperial tournament point in addition to the Crown tournament point in a month where you participate in both types of events.

You may attend as many wars as you choose and will earn ONE (1) war point for each war in which you participate. (That means ONE (1) combat war point if you fight, ONE (1) Arts/Sciences war point if you enter the competition and ONE (1) Ministry war point if you perform some ministerial function during the war.)

There is no event restriction regarding the awarding of a Master-Work. (That means that if you enter six items in the competition at a war, you may earn six Master-Works as well, even though you only get one war point.)

You may attend as many Demos as you choose and will earn all applicable points for your participation.

You may earn as many Demo Initiation points as you choose.

Here are the requirements for Knighthood as listed in the by-laws.

I have forms with these requirements available for anyone who wants them.

Regarding ministry points; the By-laws state that a member must hold an office to earn points. An acceptable alternative is earning a ministry point at an event. I.E. Water bearing, Scribing, Marshalling etc.

Performing a ministerial function of this nature considered "Holding an office" by the Ad though it be of a temporary nature.

Quoting the By-laws

3. Minister Roll.
 - a. Clarke.
 - b. Rector
 - i. Hold an office
 - ii. Participate in 1 additional demonstration.

- c. Chamberlain.
 - i. Hold an office for an additional 5 months.
 - ii. Participation in 1 additional demonstrations.
 - iii. Initiate and organize 1 demonstration.
- d. Knight Minister.
 - i. Hold an office for an additional 10 months.
 - ii. Participation in 1 war at a Crown event.
 - iii. Initiate and organize 3 additional demonstrations.
- e. Knight Civil.
 - i. Hold an office for an additional 18 months.
 - ii. Participation in 5 additional wars at Crown events.
 - iii. Initiate and organize 5 additional demonstrations.
- f. Knight Premier.
 - i. Hold an office for an additional 36 months.
 - ii. Participation in 10 additional wars at Crown events.
 - iii. Initiate and organize 15 additional demonstrations"

Regarding Arts/Sciences points; as described in the By-Laws of the Adrian Empire and above, a member may earn ONE Crown Tournament point per month. The only exception being the Imperial Tournament point.

It has been the case in the past where members have been awarded multiple points at wars.

This practice is in violation of the intention of the By-laws and will not be allowed to continue.

If multiple tournament points were allowed at wars a member might "Earn"



an Arts/Sciences Knighthood in as little as five months.

Example:

Bob the artist joins Adria and attends his first crown event.

He enters a “Medieval Widget” in the Master’s list and wins the tournament achieving a MasterWork in the process. Coincidentally, there is a war and a demo on the next weekend. Bob attends the war, enters four arts entries and gets a tourney point for each one. The next day, Bob attends the demo and eagerly shows the mundanes how widgets are made. At the next monthly event, Bob again enters the Arts/Sciences tournament this time on the knights list. Bob wins the tournament and collects his point.

As fate would have it, there is a war on the very next weekend in a neighboring Kingdom and Bob makes the road trip to participate. Once again Bob enters four items and is awarded four tourney points for his efforts. Bob goes to three demos that week and shows everyone how to make a widget, earning demo points for each. At the next monthly event, Bob enters the Arts/Sciences tournament.

A few days later, Bob goes to a demo and while showing how to make his widget, finds out about the beer war coming up later that month. Bob attends



the beer war and once again enters four items in support of his chosen side in the Arts/Sciences competition. At the next monthly event, Bob enters a different widget on the Knight’s list and hears about a little war in the neighboring Duchy. Bob goes to the war and as usual enters all four categories in the Arts/Sciences competition.

Guess what? At the next monthly event Bob becomes Sir Bob because he has 19 iTournament’s points, 5 demo points, 3 war points, a Master’s list win, a Knight’s list win and a Masterwork.

He has, in effect, met the requirements of an Arts/Sciences Knighthood in four months of membership and all this not counting the point and possible win or Masterwork that he may receive at this, his fifth event.

Now granted, this is an extreme example. It is however, possible when the By-laws are interpreted in such a manner.

It is the position of the Imperial Office of Rolls that 18 months be the normal amount of time required to attain Knighthood in all three orders in accordance with the by-laws. Once again, the exception being Imperial tournament points. Imperial tournament points would allow a member to achieve Knighthood in a minimum of 15 months since they are in addition to regular monthly Crown tournament points. It should be noted here that most Imperial events are not tournaments and therefore do not carry points other than those of a ministerial nature.

This is the source of confusion regarding Arts/Sciences war points:

Quoting the “By-Laws” here, emphasis mine:

“A member shall not be allowed to participate in more than one (1) Crown event per month for purposes of meeting their requirements for advancement.

There are two exceptions to this:

Imperial Crown events
Crown/Civil Wars.

At all Crown events members shall be afforded the opportunity to earn their requirements for advancement in their area of endeavor.”

Now, what this passage of the by-laws means is that you may participate in as

many Wars and/or Imperial events as you choose, and nothing more.

A member will receive exactly ONE (1) war point per war attended and in which participation is rendered by said member, regardless of the number of items entered by member in the war competition.

WAR POINTS ARE NOT CROWN OR IMPERIAL TOURNAMENT POINTS.

If you win the “Tournament” at a war, what you are “Winning” is the competition category war point for your side.

A member does NOT receive a Crown tournament win point at a war.

A member does NOT receive a Crown tournament participation point at a war.

(You get a war point.)

Of course, a Masterwork is still a Masterwork, wherever you earn it.

I hope I have cleared up any confusion regarding the awarding of points for the Arts/Sciences.

These are the requirements for **Knighthood in the Arts/Sciences** quoted as written in the current “By-laws” of the Adrian Empire.

- “2. Robe Roll.
 - a. Apprentice.
 - b. Journeyman.
 - i. Participation in 3 Masters’ Tourneys at Crown events.
 - c. Master.
 - i. Participation in 5 additional Masters’ Tourneys at Crown events.
 - ii. 1 win in a Masters’ Tourney at a Crown event.
 - iii. Participation in 2 demonstrations.
 - d. Knight Robe.
 - i. Participation in 10 Knights’ Tourneys at Crown events.
 - ii. 1 win in the Knights’ Tourneys at a Crown event.
 - iii. 1 master work.
 - iv. Participation in 3 additional demonstrations.
 - v. Participation in 1 war at a Crown event.

- e. Knight Doctor.
 - i. Participation in 18 additional Knights' Tournaments at Crown events.
 - ii. 5 additional wins in the Knights' Tournaments at Crown events.
 - iii. 2 additional master works.
 - iv. Participation in 5 additional demonstrations.
 - v. Participation in 3 additional wars at Crown events.
- f. Knight Master.
 - i. Participation in 36 additional Knights' Tournaments at Crown events.
 - ii. 10 additional wins in the Knights' Tournaments at Crown events.
 - iii. 4 additional master works.
 - iv. Participation in 15 additional demonstrations.
 - v. Participation in 5 additional wars at Crown events"

Here are the requirements as listed in the By-laws for **fighters**.

There have been questions regarding the requirements for second and third level Knight Combatants.

Steel participation and wins **ARE REQUIRED** for second and third level Knight Combatants.

Quoting the "By-laws" again, emphasis is mine:

- "1. Combatant Roll.
 - a. Yeoman.
 - i. Be authorized by a Knight combatant or two Sergeants and the Minister of Joust to enter the Sergeants' List.
 - b. Guardsman.
 - i. Participation in 3 Sergeants' Lists at Crown events.
 - c. Sergeant.
 - i. Participation in 5 additional Sergeants' Lists at Crown events.
 - ii. 1 win in a Sergeants' List at a Crown event.
 - iii. Participation in 2 demonstrations.
 - iv. Be authorized by a Knight combatant and the Minister of Joust to enter the Knights' List.

- d. Knight Bachelor.
 - i. Participation in 10 Knights' Lists at Crown events.
 - ii. 1 win in the Knights' Lists at a Crown event.
 - iii. Participation in 1 war at a Crown event.
 - iv. Participation in 3 additional demonstrations.
- e. Knight Bannerette.
 - i. Participation in 18 additional Knights' Lists, **of which 8 must be in the armored Knights' Lists**, at Crown events.
 - ii. 5 additional wins in the Knights' Lists, **of which 3 must be in the armored Knights' Lists**, at Crown events.
 - iii. Participation in 5 additional wars at Crown events.
 - iv. Participation in 5 additional demonstrations.
- f. Knight Champion.
 - i. Participation in 36 additional Knights' Lists, **of which 16 must be in the armored Knights' Lists**, at Crown events.
 - ii. 10 additional wins in the Knights' Lists, **of which 6 must be in the armored Knights' Lists**, at Crown events.
 - iii. Participation in 10 additional wars at Crown events.
 - iv. Participation in 15 additional demonstrations."

Now then, it is incumbent upon each member of the Adrian Empire to ensure that his/her points earned are being submitted to the Minister of Rolls via either the Autocratis report in conjunction with the Sire's report (as done here in Esperance), or via the Sireis, Baronis, Count's or Viceroy's

To the members of the Sable Crescent within the Adrian Empire, here is the July meeting message:

reports as used in other subdivisions of the Adrian Empire. Your points are your own responsibility. Make sure that your points get to the Minister of Rolls.

The Offices of the Rolls are only archives for your points. It is our responsibility to ensure that points audits are conducted in accordance with the described parameters as set forth in the By-laws.

I would also think that each member of the Adrian Empire is honor bound to provide correct information to the Rolls ministers.

If there are gaps in your points and you are aware of them, would it not be less than honorable to allow those gaps to remain when you could exert some energy to correct the mistake? I believe so.

The burden of reporting points standings is ours.

The burden of providing us the information we report is yours.

Take your points seriously but always remember: "It's just a game!"
