Canton of Aquitaine


Hot weather can not stop the Canton of Aquitaine!

About archery!

There is a debate going on about HOW MUCH equipment and area is required to supply for would be archers. First rule of thumb is, bring your own bow and arrows if you have them. If you do not, there is no shoot. In Sangreal, we are lucky to have extra fiberglass bows and arrows. A 1\$ fee has been proposed and approved, to cover the cost of replacing arrows and strings. This fee applies only to persons who do not supply their own arrows. If you do not have your own arrows, then you will be expected to pitch in to replace the ones the Archduchess is currently supplying. As with any combat sport, it should not be left up to the ones who have made the initial investment in equipment to carry the load for all. If someone refuses to allow you to borrow their equipment, see it from their point of view.

Invoice
