Imperial Crown Writ E&E-3 Conduct of Archery at Imperial Banner War April 12, 2001

Pursuant to current law, the archery war point and tournament may be conducted off-site and on different days if facilities are not available at the war site. The site of the Imperial Banner War West has no such facilities. The archery war point and Imperial tournament for said Imperial Banner War for those sites which cannot provide on-site archery will be conducted as follows. It will be shot at any practice or tournament conducted between April 26th through May 21st. Scores will be collected by the local archery minister or, in absence of the minister, the Crown or any Knight the Crown designates for this purpose.

The standard 60cm FITA target will be used. If the 60cm is not available you may use an accurate facsimile. All courses to be fired at 20 yards. A score sheet with game name, real name and candidate that is being supported will be forwarded to the Vice Chancellor, Sir Karl at ontis@compuserve.com not later than May 22nd via e-mail. Participants must either pre-register for the war paying the registration fee, postmarked by May 15th, or register at the site by close of Saturday. For your scores to count and to receive any points you must register.

The course of fire will be:

- (a) **One (1) Masters' Tournament War Point:** 6 arrows at 20 yds (possible score 60), combined score of all Masters list (bowmen).
- (b) **One (1) Knights' War Point:** 6 arrows at 20 yds (possible score 60); combined score of all Knights list (Huntsman)
- (c) **One (1) Open Tournament War Point:** 6 arrows at 20 yds (possible score 60); combined score of all masters list & knights list.
- (d) **One (1) Champion's Match War Point:** 6 arrows at 20 yds (possible score 60); highest score of any individual.

(e) **For the separate Imperial Archery tournament:** 6 arrows at 20 yds (possible score 60) Bowmans and Huntsman list.

Targets will be scored as follows:

- the inner yellow circle: 10X
- the middle yellow circle: 10
- the outer yellow circle: 9
- the inner red circle: 8
- the outer red circle: 7
- the inner blue circle: 6
- the outer blue circle: 5
- the inner black circle: 4
- the outer black circle: 3
- the inner white circle: 2
- the outer white circle: 1

Should an unforeseen event arise this writ may be used at the discretion of the Imperial Minister of Archery in conjunction of the Deputy Imperial Minister of Joust and War East for the Imperial Banner Wars.

Imperial Bylaws War Archery Revision

At the March 2001 meeting of the Imperial Estates the Estates passed a revision to Article XVI, changing the total number of points at the war from nineteen to twenty-one, the additional two points being added to the Archery making a total of four points. The revised Article

XVI.B reads then as follows (the revised portions in bold text):

B. WAR

The Minister of War will then provide a copy of the first days battles to each contender. On the following morning, after Opening Court, the battles will begin. There shall be **twenty-one (21)** war points consisting of:

- three (3) light weapons battles
- two (2) renaissance weapons battles
- one (1) renaissance champions battle
- two (2) armored battles
- one (1) armored champions battle
- eight (8) arts points (consisting of four (4) Masters' Tournament and four (4) Knights' Tournament)
- **four (4) archery points (consisting of one (1) Masters' Tournament, one (1) Knights' Tournament), one (1) Open Tournament, and one (1) Champion's Match.**

This post is rather long, but contains information about the upcoming Northern Realms Banner War. This will be a glorious war over memorial day weekend, the first war ever in the Northern Realms region of the Adrian Empire!! NorthernRealms Banner War will be taking place on the dates of Friday the 25, Saturday the 26th, and Sunday the 27th of May. The site is the Three Meadows Campground at Dworshak State Park inNorthernIdaho. RESERVATIONS!

It is important to have a reservation so we can secure enough space for everyone. Because of this, we are asking everyone to reserve ASAP so that they can be sure of having a space. The costs of the weekend or daytrips are based on what is needed to rent the site.

COSTS:

Costs are per person and include site fee for all days, and bunk space in the cabin of their choice. Costs also include access to lodge, full showers, and other amenities.

There are also five tent spaces left.

You can e-mail him at: rbezold@webtv.net NOTE: As soon as we recieve needed information from the national level regarding non profit articles of incorporation, we shall be opening an official Caerleon bank account. We will announce when this change occurs.

STAYING OVERNIGHT?:

CABINS:

For overnight visitors there is room to hold 96 people in cabins. They hold 12 people each, with bunk beds and mattresses ready for you to use your own bedroll in warm and dry comfort should the weather be all to spring like These cabin spots will be reserved for the first 96 people, but the placement is up to the attendees on a first come first serve space— that is, we will reserve a bunk for each person who makes a reservation, but you get to pick your own bunk and cabin mates. The cabins are great for those flying in or wanting to travel light— you need a bedroll and personal supplies, but you can leave that heavy tent and camping gear at home

TENTS:

For those that wish to camp, there are 10 total tent spots. These too will be offered on a first reserve - first get basis. Remember this is spring in the northwest and it may be cold and wet, or hot, as the weather dice roll. It is in the contract with the site that we do NOT set up tents except in designated spaces.

GETTING HERE:

CARPOOLS:

Carpools are certainly encouraged! If you can offer a ride to someone, please let us know. If you need a ride, please let us know too. Please place WAR CARPOOL in the subject heading of your e-mail. We will try to put those seeking transportation and those seeking riders together.

FLYING IN:

Several attendees have mentioned wishing to fly to the area to attend the war. The closest airports to the site are Lewiston Idaho and Moscow/Pullman . You may save a little bit of money coming to Spokane, Washington, as it is a larger airport, but it requires a two hour drive in a rental car to get on site, which could chew up money and time both.

FACILITIES:

There are many good facilities at this site, including several full sized showers and restrooms, a full professional cafeteria kitchen, a dining hall with benches, tables and a fireplace, and many cleared areas for combat and archery. Park rangers tell us there is a nearby convenience store with such amenities as ice, and there is a town with grocery stores minutes away— Orofino is 15 minutes, and the big town of Clarkston/Lewiston only 45 Minutes.

FOOD:

There will be on site concession of foods by the Culinary Arts

Guild of Caerleon, with all proceeds to go to the war.. There will be hot foods for breakfast, lunch, and dinners all days. A seperate post will be made in detail about the foodstuffs. The Duchy of Ekaterinegorod will be sponsoring the Saturday Evening formal feast, and will release information on that when available. A seperate bulletin on foods during the war will be released.

GENERAL and SETUP:

We officially have the site from noon on Friday until noon on Monday. Those of you traveling a long way may stay over Sunday night so that you can travel on Monday and not miss activities on Sunday (or try to leave, too tired, on Sunday). SET UP will begin Friday at noon, and TEAR DOWN will be on Monday morning— we have to be off the site at NOON. As with all sites, we attempt to leave it cleaner than when we get there so that we will have a good reputation and get good rates for future events.



Camping/Campsites

Each campsite is 120ft pull through with water, electric hook-ups, tables and grills. A comfort station with hot showers and flush toilets, a pay phone and playground are located in the camping area. Fees are \$13.00 per campsite, which sleeps up to 6 people. Fifteen campsites are reserved. The Adrian Empire has paid for the first night. This will be reimbursed to the Adrian Empire, via the Autocrat, by April 23rd. Additional nights will also be the paid to Marquessa Etaine by April 23rd or unpaid sites will be cancelled. If you desire to use a credit card for the additional nights please contact us and we will make the needed arrangements.

Cabins

Two bedroom cabins are available. But there is a limited number, so if you are interested call the reservations' number listed above. The cost for cabins can range from \$60-70 per night, call the reservations line for that weekends rate.

Parking


A \$2.00 per day parking fee is required. This is to be obtained upon arrival from the park office.

Site Taxes

\$12.00 per person, \$6.00 for children ages 6-12 (under 6 free). The site taxes are to cover the two separate building we are using. We will have an Arts building and a Feast building. If site taxes are not paid for, you will not be allowed to participate in the war. It is only fair that every member pays his or her share. Site Taxes are to be pre-paid to Marquessa Etaine no later than April 23, 2001. Cash will not be accepted. Please make checks or money orders payable to The Adrian Empire. Please include a list names for which the taxes are being paid for.

Event Information:

We are planning to have the Arts tournament in the Chapel Hall (the location of last year's feast). The feast will be held in the group lodge. Thus the Arts tournament has a facility on to



itself, judges have air conditioning, and projects can be locked in the building overnight. This idea is tentative though, if we do not get a sufficient amount of site fees by the deadline of April 23, we may have to cancel the group lodge and hold both the Arts tournament and the feast in the same building.

Court:



The event will be held in the Kingdom of Terre Neuve at the Dos Picos Regional Park, 17953 Dos Picos Park Road, Ramona, CA. The site opens at Noon on Friday May 25th, and closes at 2 pm on Monday May 28. On-site registration will be held Friday night from 7pm to 9pm, Saturday morning from 8am to 10am and during lunch break, and Sunday morning from 8am to 9am and during lunch break. Pre-registration is available by mail using the enclosed form postmarked by May 15th. Please help expedite the onsite registrations by either pre-registering or bringing an already completed registration form with you. Opening Court for both days will be held at 10:00am. Imperial audiences will be available during lunch breaks. Electronic copies of this information and the registration form will be available at the Adrian Herald website <http://home.att.net/~adrianherald>.

There will be an Imperial tournament held, being separate from the overall war. There is no archery available on site, so please refer to the Crown Writ regarding the conduct of archery for Banner War. We will need water bearers, combat marshals, art's judges, and scribes. There will be a feast Saturday night, which is included in your registration fee. If you are interested in volunteering please contact the event autocrat. Your help is greatly appreciated and needed. Any and all court business needs to be forwarded to Sir Nigel the Byzantine before the war. Official court business will be conducted during the Imperial Court, followed by time for Imperial audiences thereafter. This allows those officers whose attendance is required during Imperial Court to tend to other business if need be while personal audiences, knightings, and miscellaneous announcements are made. If you have an announcement you would like read at Court please get it to Sir Nigel in writing in advance, include your contact information and be sure to specify who people are to contact if they have questions regarding the topic.

Site/Event/Feast Fees:
