DESERT ALLIANCE, YORK TRIUMPH AT BANNER WARS

"Desert Alliance" of Aragon, Umbria, Sangreal and Brandenburg defeated the "Coastal Alliance," composed of members from the kingdoms of Esperance and Terre Neuve at the Imperial Banner War West, held at Featherly Park in Southern California on May 25th and May 26th, while "York" triumphed at Banner War East, held at Coffee State Park in Georgia.

Banner War East

Banner War East was well-attended with nearly 60 people from Chesapeake, Dragon's Mist and York in attendance. To encourage the "fun" aspect of war, combatants drew letters to be in either Army A or Army B (the "banner" was conceded to York, who attended the event with a 40-member army). After a close-fought battle, Army B was declared the "winner."

Court at the War was busy, with no less than five knightings:

Dame Etaine Llewelyn (York) elevated to Knight Civil (2nd level)

Dame Josephine Oakesblood (York) elevated to Knight Civil (2nd level)

Oriana (York) elevated to Knight Bachelor (1st level)

Dame Kyra Evaine (Chesapeake) elevated to Knight Huntsman (2nd level)

Sir Killian Oakesblood (York) elevated to Knight Bannerette (2nd level) and Knight Civil (2nd level)

The feast at the war was well-attended, and many of the War's combatants enjoyed "Lamb Hosted Wright," a revel hosted by Lord Wright of Yorkshere. The general consensus by the participants of the Banner War East was that a good time was had by all.

Banner War West

Nearly 180 people from Aragon, Brandenburg, Esperance, Sangreal, Terre Neuve, Tierra del Fuego and Umbria met at Featherly Park in the Anaheim Hills for the Banner War West. The weather was perfect, with clear sunny days and a gentle afternoon breeze to cool the combatants.

A Pas de Armes was held for the knights who wished to display their prowess with weapons, and Sir Jamie the Red of

Esperance was declared to be the best of the event, while Sir Nicolai "won the prize" in the display of rapier prowess. The name of the shinai list winner was not available at press time.

A small Arts and Sciences competition, using the new Arts Manual for the first time in judging entries for a war. Dame Elisabeth Grey, Imperial Arts and Sciences Minister, deemed the "experiment" a success. Three of the four entries received at least 15 points (the minimum score for a participation), and Sir Michael Sinestro was awarded both a Tournament Win and a Masterwork for his rhyming translation of Geoffrey Chaucer's "Wife of Bath." Everyone is looking forward to the Imperial War, which should host a large and competitive Arts and Sciences list.

Several collegia were held during the weekend. The Lucet class taught by Malaika Ayana of Umbria proved so popular the class was held twice, while Milicent de Lacey taught people the secrets of her famous apple liqueur.

Court at the War saw three knights of Adria elevated:

Sir Nigel Seymour of Huntington (Brandenburg) elevated to Knight Premier (3rd level)

Sir Coda der Drackesohn von Seiken (Esperance) elevated to Knight Champion (3rd level)

Civix Wartongue was elevated to Knight Bachelor (1st level)

Congratulations to the elevated peers, their families, and households.

Contenders Declare

As decreed by Imperial Writ, contenders for the throne of Adria had until the end of the Banner War to declare their intentions. At this time, two contenders from the western regions of the Empire have publicly declared: Sir Johann Warhammer, Earl of Terre Neuve, and His Imperial Majesty, Sir Karl von Katzburg with Her Imperial Highness, Dame Elisabeth Grey. As of press time, it was not known if a contender in the East had declared.

EMPIRE ADOPTS UNIFORM MEMBERSHIP DATE

At the March 2002 Imperial Estates Meeting, annual memberships were changed to cover July 1st through June 30th. This means that everyone's membership term will be synchronized to cover that period. Sir Terrin Greyphis, the Imperial Steward, was tasked with making this happen including defining a membership proration to get everyone on track.

A new membership form has been released and is available at <http://www.greyphis.net>. All stewards should begin to use this form immediately. Any new member joining Adria should use this form and not any prior form. Any current member that is renewing, should use this form and write in the amount that they are paying on the blank provided.

Answers to key questions

How much do I need to pay? When do I need to pay it? How do I avoid a lapse in membership?

How much and when you need to pay your renewal this year is based on when your expiration date was.

If you expire prior to June 1st, 2002, use the new member rate shown on the bottom of the new membership form and your membership will be good through June 30th, 2003. As normal, if you pay on or before 30 days after your expiration date, there is no lapse. The amounts are as follows:

Membership type:	Participating	E-Discount	Additional Family Membership
April	\$39	\$26	\$13
May	\$36	\$24	\$12

If you expire between June 1st, 2002 and July 31st, 2002, you are within a month of the new expiration date which is close enough not to worry about. Use the new form and pay the standard annual amount and you will be good through June 30th, 2003. As normal, if you pay on or before 30 days after your expiration date, there is no lapse. The amounts are as follows:

Membership type:	Participating	E-Discount	Additional Family Membership
	\$30	\$20	\$10

If you expire after July 31st, 2002, you will have two options:

1) All participating members will receive a letter and/or e-mail and all e-discount members will receive an e-mail that shows a credit amount that may be applied towards an annual membership renewal. Families will receive a single notification as group. Apply this credit to the standard annual rates (\$30, \$20, \$10) **no later than July 31st** and your membership will be good through June 30th, 2003. **This option is only available if paid by July 31st, 2002.** Selecting option 2 instead of this option does NOT constitute a lapse. If you have any questions or feel that the credit amount may be in error, please contact Sir Terrin Greyphis, Imperial Steward.

2) Your second option is to wait until around the time you expire (paying early is always acceptable). At this time or any time after July 31st, you may use the rates shown on the new membership form. Normally these rates will only apply to new members, but as a one time conversion, you may use them to pay the remaining membership until June 30th, 2003. Note that if you have already paid your membership through April, May, or June 2003, a slightly larger amount will be due in order to take your membership through to June 30th, 2004. As normal, if you renew within 30 days of your expiration date, there will be no lapse.

Hey, what about associate members?

Per the bylaws,

"An entity which is an organization, or a Chartered Subdivision thereof (or equivalent), may purchase associate membership for its members. The dues for said membership per member would be set by the Imperial Crown in consideration of the number of memberships requested, and the cost of providing them with Imperial Services."

Please have the representative of the group contact the Imperial Crown or Imperial Steward's Office for more information. Be sure to provide not only the name of your organization (RMS, ECS, or SCA), but the subdivision that you are representing and how many members of that subdivision you are representing.

EMPRESS AND EMPEROR ESTABLISH UNIVERSITY

In the tradition of great rulers, Their Imperial Majesties have established an Imperial University. Her Imperial Majesty unveiled plans for the university at the March Imperial Estates meeting:

"The Chancellor ensures the "legality" of our estates. But who will tell us of historical law? The Minister of Joust and War monitors the tournaments to be sure everything is done properly. But who will teach us of the battles of old? Or show us the techniques and styles of fighting? The Minister Arts and Science focuses on the tournaments. But who will teach us about the things we are recreating? The ministers are the administrators of the Empire. They have their hands full. Besides, they were chosen for their skills at administrating, not necessarily their knowledge of history.

"Adria is one of the rare groups that tolerates excellence. As a group, we are open to the idea of participating at many levels of accuracy. We have found a way to accommodate those who thirst for knowledge without overtaxing our existing ministers.

"We are creating the Adrian University, which will focus on history and education. There will be the College of Arts of War, and of the Arts of Peace. Guilds will be a part of the University system. The University will work alongside their ministry counterparts, just with a different focus."

The first of the colleges to be established was the College of the Arts of Peace, which will focus on the Arts and Sciences. Dame Maud de Clayton of Tierra del Fuego was named as Dean of the College. The College met its first challenge when called upon to organize classes for Banner War West in late May; while only a few were held, the response to them was favorable, and more classes are planned for the Imperial War in late August.

The College has found an "electronic" home, thanks to the generosity of Sir Dragonet of Ekaterinagorod, at <http://groups.yahoo.com/group/Adria-Collegia>. This site includes a place for announcements, message lists, areas for the posting of photographs and files, and a calendar of upcoming events.

The College is also pleased to announce the formation of two new guilds: in Umbria, a Weavers' Guild has been established by Malaika Ayana, and in Cambridge, a Brewers' Guild known as "The Brethren of Bacchus" has been established by the Viceroy, Kaeyron Aramis Maethanos. BANQUETS

While the term "banquet" now means a formal dinner of some type, banquets in the 16th century were popular parties similar to today's dessert receptions. Composed overwhelmingly of sweet dishes, fruits, and small baked goods, menus for these festive affairs were included in 16th century recipe books including *The Good Huswife's Handmaide for the Kitchin* (c. 1595), *The English Huswife* by Gervase Markham (1615) and *The Good Housewife's Jewel* by Thomas Dawson (1596).

Banquets usually consisted of several tables, each containing a number of small dishes containing different sweets. Markham suggests that the host or hostess, "serve your banquetting stuffe in Silver or Gilt Boules, or Glasse Plates, and set your Boules on the Table..." in groups, with a marchpane (sugar plate or sculpture) at each end and in the middle. Dishes that could be served at a banquet included "biskets and mackroones" (cookies), dried cherries and apricots, marchpane, small cakes, preserved fruits, suckets (candied citrus peels), and marmalades, stiff pastes of cooked fruits.

Banquets can be festive events for the end of a tournament, and are suitable for outdoor events. Most modern cookbooks on medieval cooking contain recipes for different dishes suitable for banquets, including: *All the King's Cooks: The Tudor Kitchens of King Henry VIII at Hampton Court Palace* by Peter Brears; *To the Queen's Taste: Elizabethan Feasts and Recipes* by Lorna Sass; and *Food and Cooking in 16th Century Britain: History and Recipes* by Peter Brears. A few recipes have been reproduced below.

Marchpane

(from *All the King's Cooks* by Peter Brears)

Marchpane, now known as marzipan, was an essential ingredient for any banquet. A stiff doughy material made of blanched ground almonds, sugar and rosewater, marchpane could be colored and shaped with moulds to create sculptures, plaques, and novelties. To make marchpane:

8 oz. blanched ground almonds
4 oz. confectioners's sugar
3 tablespoons rosewater
Glaze (see below)
Colored comfits (optional)
Gold Leaf (optional)

Mix the almonds and rosewater in a bowl. Stir in the icing sugar and work together with the back of a spoon to form a smooth, very firm dough. Do not overmix, or it will become oily.

Once mixed, line the bottom and sides of a 7-inch round springform pan with baking parchment. Place the dough inside and smooth until level with a spatula. Brush with glaze and decorate with comfits, then bake for 30 minutes in a 175 °F

oven. Repeat as necessary until quite firm. Let cool completely and finish decorating with comfits and gold leaf if desired.

Glaze: Mix together 1 teaspoon rosewater, 1 tablespoon confectioners' sugar and 1 tablespoon rice flour until smooth.

Jellied Milk

(from *Food and Cooking in 16th Century Britain* by Peter Brears)

5 tablespoons gelatine
16 oz. milk
4 oz. sugar
1 ½ tablespoons rosewater

Sprinkle the gelatine onto 4 tablespoons of the milk in a cup and let stand for 5 minutes to soften gelatine. Stand the cup in hot water and stir until the gelatine is completely dissolved.

Warm the remaining milk, stir in the gelatine and the sugar, and simmer, stirring continuously, for 5 minutes. Remove from heat, stir in the rosewater, and pour into a freshly cold-water rinsed shallow baking dish.

Store in a cool place until firm, then cut into square with a sharp knife. Either arrange on a dish in a regular pattern, or stack in a pyramid on a plate before serving.

Jumbles

(from *Food and Cooking in 16th Century Britain* by Peter Brears)

These knotted biscuits are first boiled, then baked to create a chewy, delicious baked item.

2 eggs
4 oz. sugar
6 oz. flour
1 tablespoon aniseed

Beat the eggs, then beat in the sugar, the seeds, and then the flour. The dough should be stiff but not sticky.

Fill a pot with water and bring to a boil.

Turn onto a lightly floured board and break off a piece, forming it into a roll about 3/8" thick. Tie one end into a loose overhand knot, slice the knot off with a sharp knife, and tie another knot, repeating the process until all the dough has been turned into knots.

Gently put the knots into the boiling water 5 to 6 at a time, using a spoon to gently free them from the bottom of the pot. When they rise (usually within 1 to 2 minutes), remove them with a slotted spoon and place them on a clean cloth to dry.

Preheat oven to 350 °F.

Place the dried jumbles on greased cookie sheets and bake for 15 minutes at 350 °, then turn them over and bake for an additional 15 minutes. When baked, transfer to a rack to cool completely, then store in an airtight tin until ready to use.

Marmalade of Peaches or Apricots (from *All the King's Cooks* by Peter Brears)

1½ pounds peaches or apricots
8 oz. sugar
3 tablespoons rosewater

Lightly grease a shallow baking pan.

Peel and stone the fruit, and weigh the flesh; you need at least 1 pound. Chop the flesh and rub through a sieve to make a smooth puree. Combine the puree, sugar, and rosewater in a heavy-bottomed saucepan and bring to a boil, stirring continuously. Boil until the mixture stiffens and darkens to a dark-orange color; it is very important to stir continuously, or the mixture will burn and the taste will be spoiled.

Chill a plate in the refrigerator, and drop a small bit of the mixture onto the plate from a spoon to check if it is cooked enough to set very firmly. If stiff enough, pour into the greased pan and allow to cool completely. Once cool, slice into small squares and dust with baker's sugar.

Fyne Cakes (from *To the Queen's Taste* by Lorna Sass)

6 oz. butter, room temperature
4 oz. sugar
1 egg, separated
1 ¾ cups sifted flour
½ teaspoon cloves
1/8 teaspoon mace
pinch ground saffron

Preheat oven to 325 °F.

In a bowl, cream butter, add sugar and beat until fluffy.

In a separate bowl, beat egg yolk until thick and lemony, then add to the butter-sugar mixture and blend thoroughly.

Sift together the flour and spices, then add to the butter mixture, mixing thoroughly with the hands. The dough will be stiff.

Press mixture into a 9-inch square baking pan. Brush top slightly with egg white.

Bake at 325 °F for 45 minutes, or until cake feels firm when pressed lightly in the center.

Cut into small squares while still hot, but let cool completely in pan on wire rack.

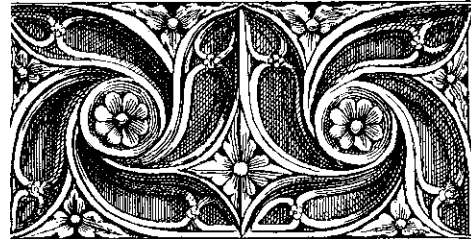
